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Signs and symptoms of a Urinary Tract Infection (UTI)

If your child is followed by our practice and has any new onset of the following symptoms, they could have a UTI.

- Burning or pain with urination
- Fever without cold or flu symptoms
- Stomach pain
- Back pain
- Nausea
- Worsening or new onset urinary incontinence, day or night
- Foul smelling urine
- Voiding significantly more frequently
- Sensation to void but cannot void
- Urinary hesitancy

If you notice any of these symptoms, and your child has a history of urinary tract infections or vesicoureteral reflux, please call our office. One of our staff will be happy to assist you.
