**Techniques for placing eyedrops in eye**

1. Lie flat on a couch or bed
2. Pull the lower eyelid down in the center to make a larger target
3. Hold the bottle 2” above the eye and place the eyedrop in the pocket of the lower eyelid
4. Close the eye without blinking for 30 seconds to let the drop absorb
5. Wait at least 5 minutes between eyedrops.
